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












ALICIA FAI COUSAS



He holds a degree in Art History and a diploma in Film Directing from the Centre d'Estudis Cinematogràfics de Catalunya. Las Altas Presiones (2014), his second fiction feature film, premiered at the Busan International Film Festival (BIFF) and won the Nuevas Olas Award at the Seville European Film Festival (SEFF). 





Alberto Díaz López (Bóveda, 1984), as an artist-in-residence, has enjoyed one of the most important national contemporary art grants of the Royal Academy of Spain in Rome due to the creation of a documentary essay entitled Lembranza. He had been awarded one of the five AGADIC talent grants for his previous short film: Exhalación. His first short film Stringless was defined as "a work with the capacity to innovate in the form of a hypertonal montage and which has an exciting post-modern structure" at the Ca'Foscari Festival in Venice. Passionate about the triangle of the poetic, the sensorial and film theory, he is currently working on the script for his first feature film, Merlo branco. He has generally carried out simultaneous scriptwriting, directing and postproductionwork besides having his own production company Mordisco Films. He has more than 1875, selections and 345 international awards. As a producer, last year he presented the feature film La mala madre at the Fastastic 7 of the Marche du Film in Cannes.

David lives alone with his cat, Sandwich Cat. It seemed like just another ordinary day, but an unexpected visit will lead him to a crucial reflection for humanity.









Anxos Fazáns. Pontevedra, 1992. She studied Audiovisual Communication at the Uvigo, the Master's Degree in Film Directing at ESCAC and the Master's Degree in Contemporary Art, Creation and Research at Uvigo. A Estación Violenta is her first feature film. An adaptation of the novel of the same name by Manuel Jabois produced by Matriuska and starring Alberto Rolán, Nerea Barros, Xose Barato and Antonio Durán Morris. It has travelled to several international festivals, including the Seville European Film Festival and the BAFICI in Buenos Aires. It has also received 8 nominations for the Mestre Mateo Awards of the Galician Academy. In 2019, he released the short film *Analóxica*, produced by Erika Lust, which was screened in the competitive sections of BAFICI and Curtocircuíto. That same year he inaugurated the video installation *Sed*, the result of the Injuve 2019 Artistic Residencies. She is currently developing her next film As Liñas Descontinuas (The Dashed Lines), selected for the ECAM Incubator and the Sources2 script lab.

Synopsis

Después de nada (After Nothing) is the diary of a journey-shipwreck in search of the experience of emptiness from the Nepalese Himalayas to its antipode in the Chilean Atacama Desert, between 2014 and 2015. The integrative and cumulative gaze, inherent to every journey, is captured through Super 8 filming which, like the natural landscape, resists any attempt at predetermination or uniform discourse.



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Carla Andrade (Vigo, 1983) has a Degree in Audiovisual Communication and a Master's Degree in Artist's Film & Moving Image at Goldsmiths University in London, besides studying Philosophy at the Spanish National Distance Education University (UNED). She has carried out artistic residencies in Iceland, Nepal, Chile, Sweden, Central African Republic, Barcelona, Bilbao and Paris, among others. He has exhibited individually in contemporary art centres such as MAC Gas Natural Fenosa, CDAN, Casa das Artes de Vigo or Galería Trinta; collectively, in the Guggenheim Museum of Bilbao, MARCO de Vigo, Tabacalera, Caixaforum, La Casa Encendida, Le 104 Paris, Lux London etc; and in international film and photography festivals such as IFFR, Zinebi, PortoPostDoc, Curtas Vila do Conde, Alchemy Film Festival, Ficunam, PhotoEspaña or Encontros da Imagem. She has received awards such as Absolut//Collection 2013, Franc Vila Galería Luis Adelantado 2013, Primer Premio Artes Plásticas UCM 2014, Premio Fotografía SUMMA 2015, Best Galician Film PlayDoc 2022, etc. and grants from Injuve, BilbaoArte, VEGAP, Agadic or the Institut Français, among others.

A man arrives at an old house in an uninhabited village in the Ribeira Sacra. There he spends his days without speaking, isolated from humanity and connected to nature.

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

Finalist for the I Mahou Barrica Award of Audiovisual Narrative with *Camiño* de inverno (Winter Way). I Prize in the VII Certame Curtas Asociación Socio-Pedagóxica Galega short film Rosalía with the actress Melania Cruz, selected by the prestigious curator Christian Caujoulle to participate and exhibit her photography at the Reencontros de Arlés (France). Her training in photography began in 2006 with renowned masters such as Isabel Muñoz, Ralph Gibson, Paolo Roversi, Antoine d'Agata and Ellen Kooi, among others. In 2021 she founded the production company Martela Films, a company invited by the Zinemaldia (San Sebastian Film Festival) as part of Meet Them 2022.

Synopsis

To Bird or Not to Bird is a short film that uses black and absurd humour to construct a story of social criticism. The main character is a wooden Cuckoo that, far from enjoying the freedom that birds are supposed to have, has adopted a way of life similar to that of today's humans, living in an urban environment and suffering from the same health and environmental problems that surround us all. The stories of the rest of the characters that intertwine with the protagonist's will serve to relate, in an ironic tone, the conflict between the natural and the artificial, the dilemmas and obstacles that we live with and, above all, to denounce our lack of freedom.









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Martín Romero (Boiro, 1981) is an illustrator, comic author and animation director. As an illustrator he won several awards such as the Injuve 2007 or the Junceda Award for the best editorial design for the album *La invasión de los ultracuerpos* by The New Raemon (Bcore, 2009). He is the author of three graphic novels for adults: As fabulosas crónicas do rato taciturno (Ed. SinsEntido & Apa Apa, 2011), Episodios lunares (Vidas de Papel & Reino de Cordelia, 2015) and A débeda (La Cúpula, 2017), all translated into French; a children's graphic novel awarded with the Castelao Prize 2019: Uxío (Astiberri, 2020); and a web-comic entitled O manual das pedras. In the field of animation, he wrote and directed his first short film A noite (2017) and did background and lighting work on several projects.







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
