Ashling Ocampo Colvin (2000) graduated in Audiovisual Communication from Vigo University. She is currently taking a master's degree in Scriptwriting for Film and Television at ESCAC+ MediaPro Studio.

While at university, Ashling did internships at the Novos Cinemas Festival, Sétima Film and CTV Production Companies. She has also participated and been awarded at the Fasmuvis and A Fume de Carozo contests. During her final year at university, she worked as a scriptwriter on the film María Balteira, a didactic short film for the production company Sétima, in the context of the Galicia Awards. Before moving to Barcelona to focus on scriptwriting, she worked for the television production company CTV as a production assistant, props manager and editorial assistant.

As a final degree project, she wrote, produced and directed a short film called Grandmas's House which focuses on functional diversity with a feel-good drama. Distributed by YAQ, the film had its premiere at the Ourense International Film Festival, where it received the first FasCurtas award.

DIRECTOR'S BIO

Diego studied Stage Direction at ESAD in Galicia and a Master's Degree in Film Directing at ESCAC. In 2020 he founded the production company Coven Films in Vigo. Canibalismo is his first short film, an adaptation of the play of the same name by Marcos Abalde, which between 2021 and 2022 travelled to 40 festivals and won a Méliès d'Argent for the Best European Fantastic Film Short Film. Currently, Diego is finalising the distribution process of his second short film, Somnia, which is financed by AGADIC, among other personal projects. At the same time, he works at the ACT Galicia acting school as a teacher of on-camera acting. *Monstera* is his third short film as a director, in which he will be supported by the producer Alfonso Zarauza and his production firm Maruxiña Films Company.

SYNOPSIS

Nuria Vilán has created a poetic universe based on La Maradona, the leader of a youth gang in Vigo in the 1980s, where the visual language of underworld cinema blends with the dark history of Vigo, as she brings into the present references of contemporary Galician literature and a powerful vindication of the LGBTIAQ+ collective. This Alba Domínguez-directed piece combines Super 8 footage from Manoel da Costa's Vigo archive from the 1980s with fictional footage shot in and around Vigo, Nigrán and in the historic 1968 Cometa bus provided by Vitrasa.













Born in Meaño in 1997, she graduated in Audiovisual Communication from Vigo University and during her Erasmus stay in Lisbon she focused on film editing (fiction and non-fiction films) and she co-directed experimental short films such as Lázaro, selected at festivals including IndieLisboa.

She is also a student in the Sound for Audiovisual Media and Performances Higher Education Cycle, and has worked on projects such as the live sound of the short documentary Os Corpos by Eloy Domínguez Serén, and the sound design of experimental

She currently combines her film editing work with music video projects, either as a director, editor or cinematographer.













PRODUCER'S BIO

Nuria Vilán Prado (Sto. André de Comesaña, Vigo, 1993) is a reciter a.k.a. in the performing arts scene as Nuria Vil. Her work focuses on taking poetry beyond the written word, seeking to blend words with forms of experimental and performative art through a discourse marked by social vindication. She has performed in Indóciles (2024, with Mónica de Nut and Vero Rilo), Dúas Gamberras e un Micro, Por Xela... She won the 2022 Bolsa Ensaia award in a recognition of her professional career. In 2024 she premiered the performance Declaro deserto (saxophone and spoken word) created as part of the 2023 In Situ Residency (DIDAC Foundation), the in-progress art installation Abride sinal (Granell Foundation) and also the short film Delincuente, based on an unpublished poem of the same name. Her first and only collection of poetry is *Simún* (ed. Chan da Pólvora, 2021), although her work has been published as part of several anthologies and remains in oral tradition.

As if it were the end of the world. By the next morning, the sounds will gleam in the bright daylight.

The Galician filmmaker Daniel Pérez Silva (Boiro, Spain, 1999) has both written and directed the short films Garza (2020), Persoa, pobo, paisaxe (2021) and Viaxar aos teus recordos é buscar pelexa (2023), which have been screened at festivals such as Alcances, Mecal Pro, Play-Doc, Curtocircuíto, CortoGijón, Aguilar Film Festival and NIFF, among others.

SYNOPSIS

Adela has a mental disorder (not recognized by her) that drives her to seek relief in religion and popular rituals. She feels misunderstood both by her family and by the medical and mental health community, where medication is presented as the absolute solution to all her problems. She needs someone to listen to what is really happening to her. She believes she is being watched and feels a presence that sometimes touches and hurts her, leaving her bedridden for days. The only place her reality finds a place is in religion, so she goes to a healer and tells her everything.













DIRECTOR'S BIO

Bea Lema (A Coruña, 1985) is an illustrator and comic author trained as a product designer at the A Coruña University, and began her professional career in 2011 working for the Sargadelos porcelain company. Since 2013 she has developed her work independently, focusing on illustration and comics. She was awarded the 12th Castelao Comic Prize of the Coruña Provincial Council in 2017 for O corpo de Cristo (The Body of Christ). An autobiographical project exploring mental illness from the perspective of a young girl, this is her first graphic novel.

In 2022 she received a scholarship to complete a graphic novel residency at the Maison des Auteurs in Angoulême (France), between January and June 2022.
