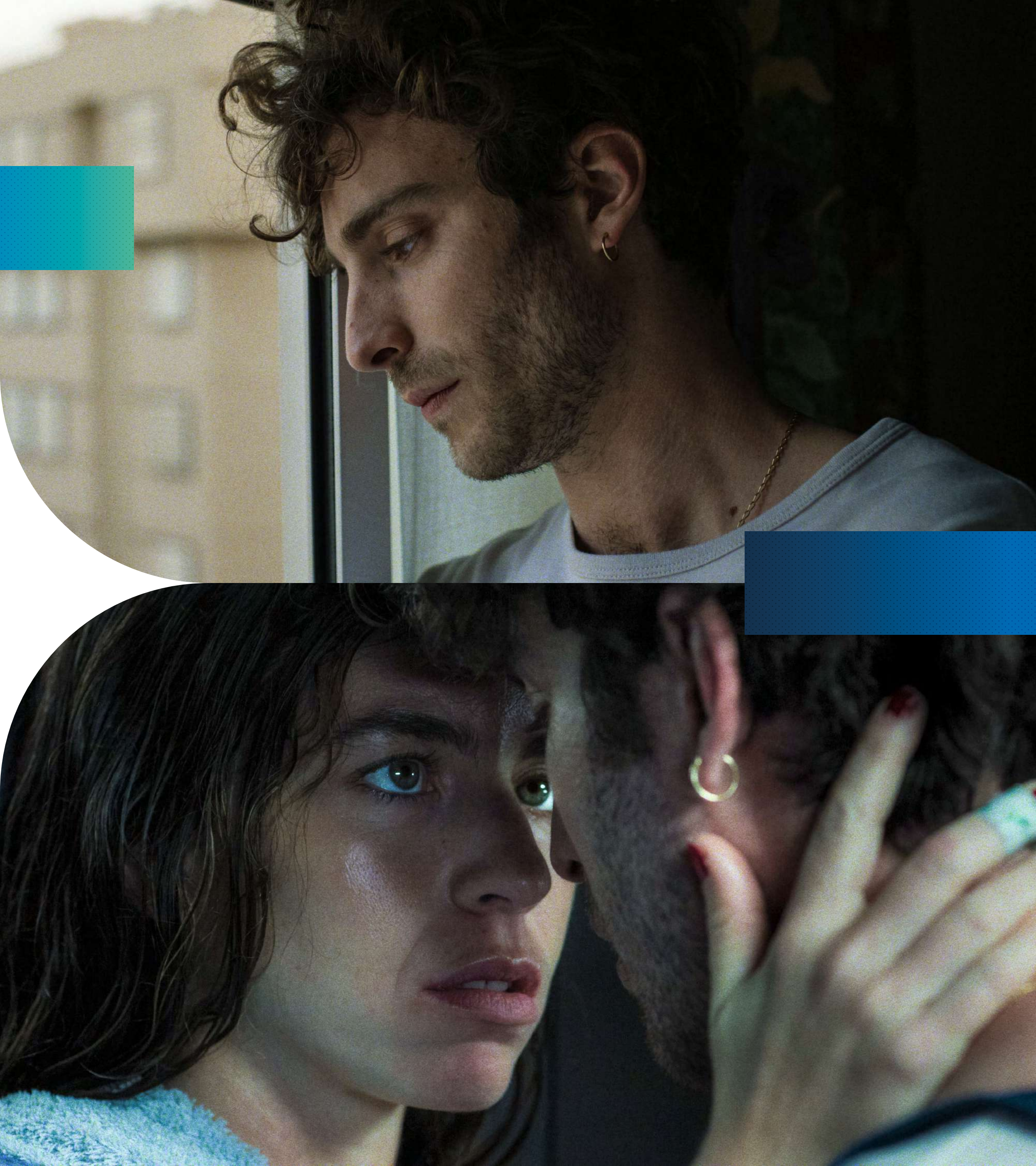

DIRECTOR'S BIO

Juan Lorenzo Loureiro, Boiro, 1990. After an unremarkable degree in an uninspiring major at USC, he studied cinematography for four years at the Bande à Part Film School in Barcelona. At the same time, he attended various courses and masterclasses, including an avant-garde film course at Xcèntric (CCCB), which made him rediscover the endless possibilities of cinema.

He has participated in workshops with filmmakers such as Víctor Erice, Pedro Costa, Lucrecia Martel, José Luís Guerín, Peter Tscherkassky, and Nelly Quettier, the regular film editor for Claire Denis and Leos Carax. He has received grants from ICAA, ICEC, and the Provincial Councils of A Coruña and Tarragona.

His work combines narrative fiction with experimental filmmaking. Beyond categorization, his work revolves around darkness, mystery, and texture. His approach to the image is highly physical, aiming to capture the pulse of both characters and spaces.

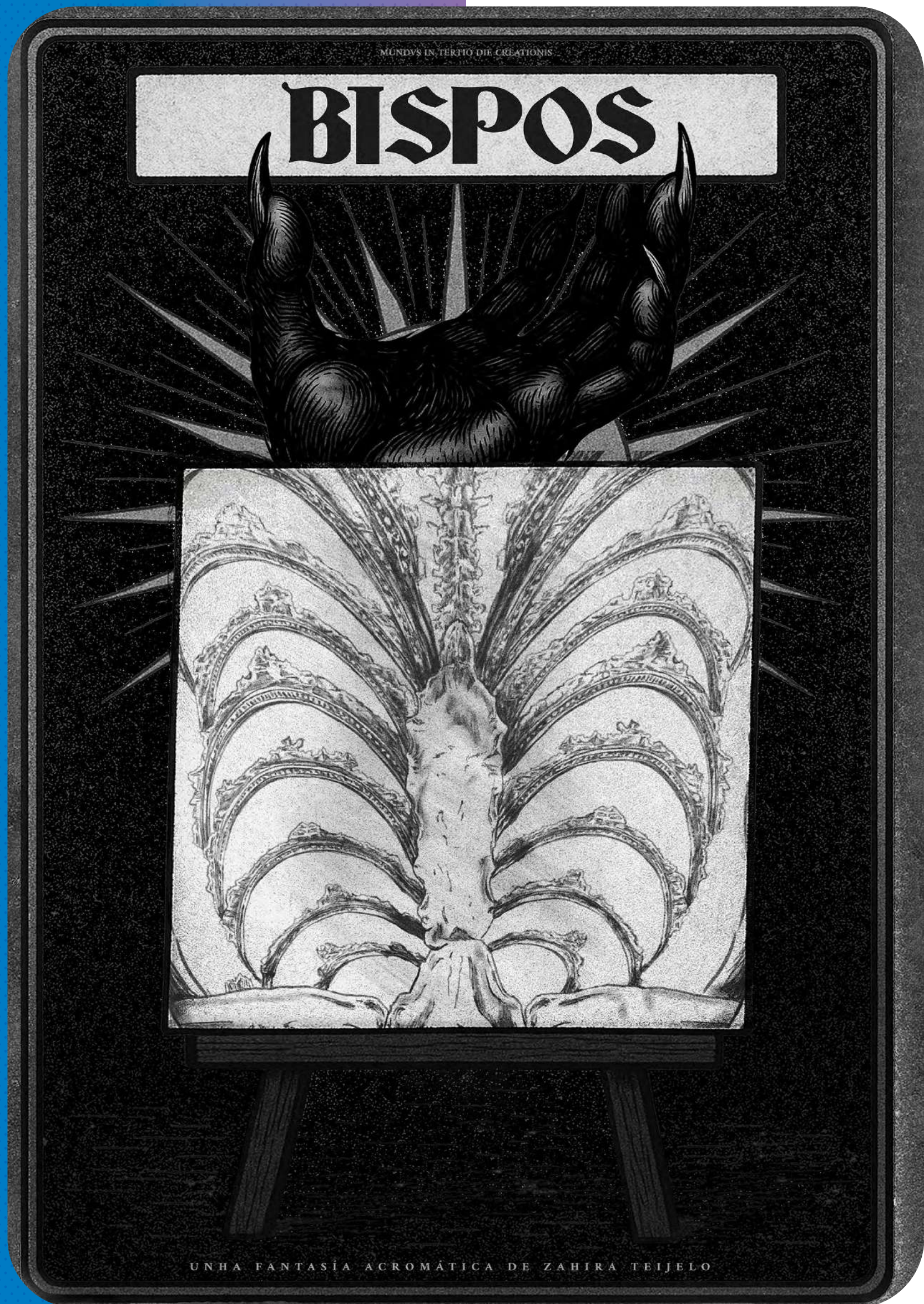

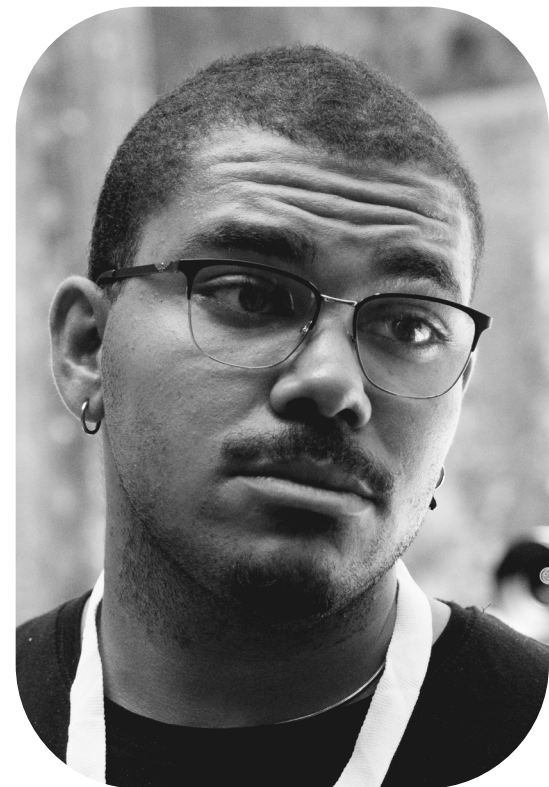

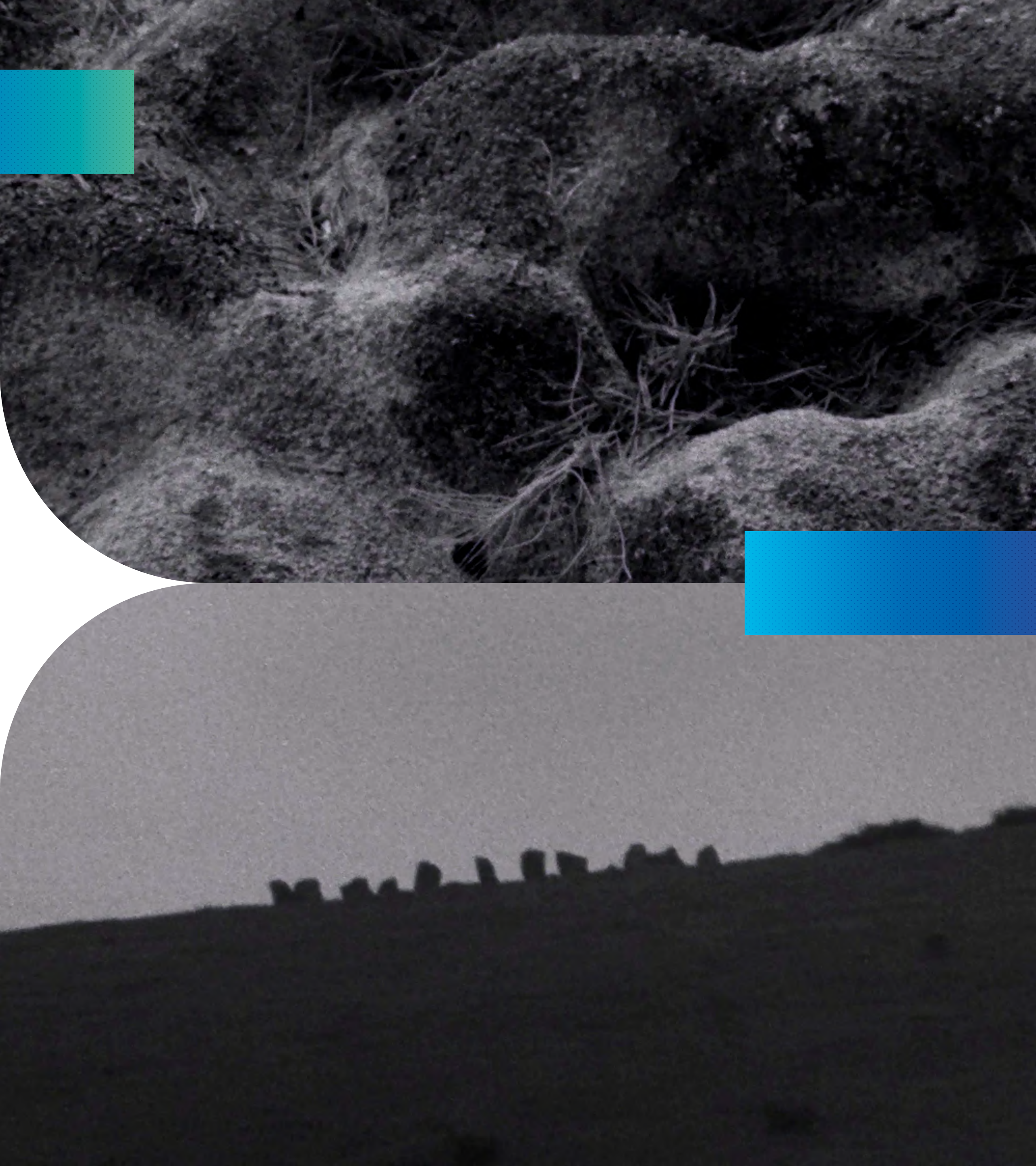

SYNOPSIS

A Pena [Galician noun that could mean: 1. A large and prominent rock 2. A feeling of pain or moral anguish] is a visual and sensory exploration of the unique rock formations that inhabit the landscape where I grew up, in the Terra Chá region. In an intimate dialogue with the land, the camera approaches the stones with the gaze of someone attempting to name the world for the first time, recognizing in them the ancestral, silent, and living language. It is an exercise in observation and belonging, where each stone becomes a gesture, a memory, and an unanswered question.

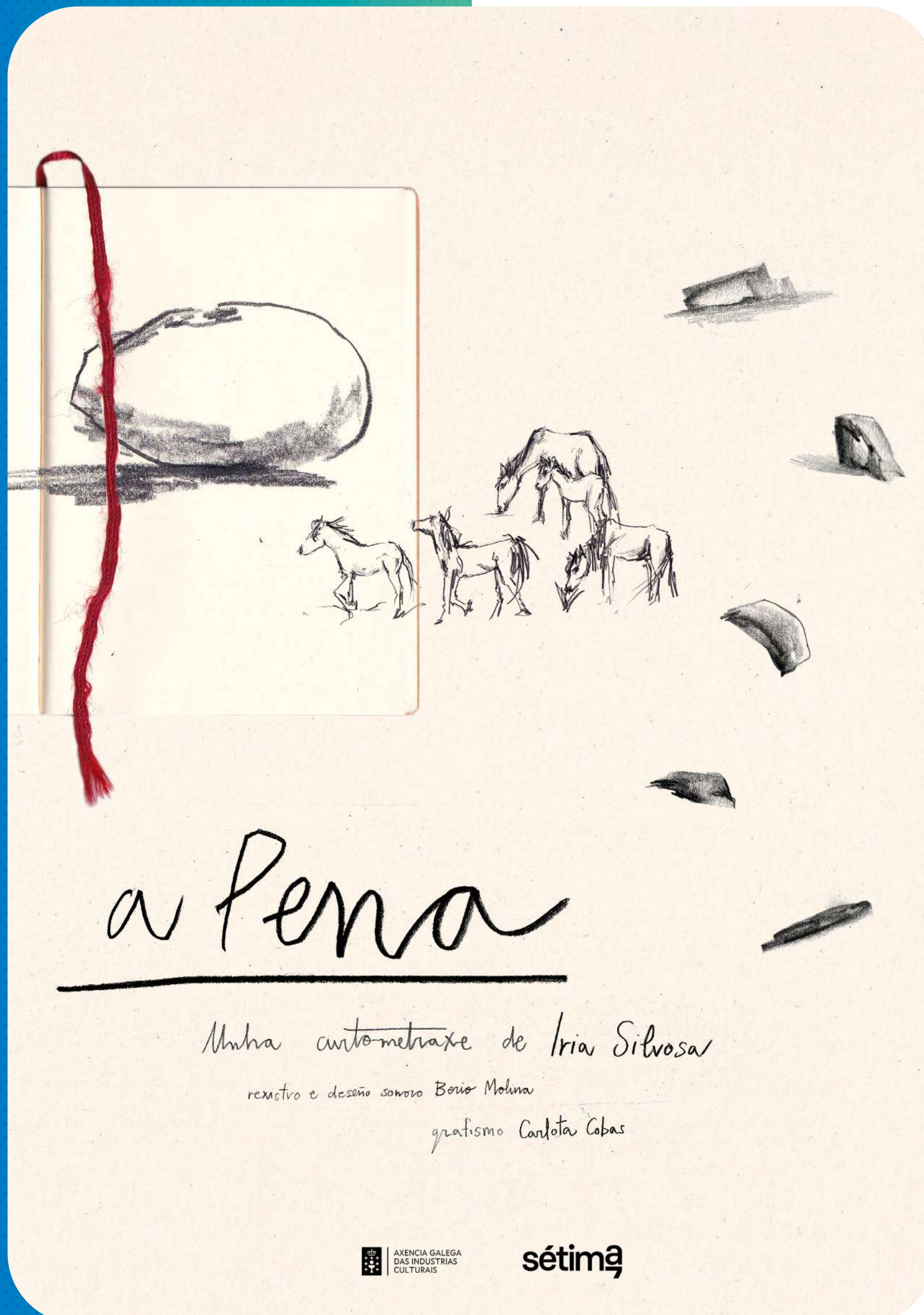

Iria Silvora Peteira (Vilalba, 1992) studied Audiovisual Communication specializing in Editing and Post-production. She is a working-partner at NUMAX S. Coop. Galega. Her career follows two parallel paths: creation and editing. As an editor, she mainly works on projects that explore narrative limits, such as *A estación violenta* by Anxos Fazáns (2017) and *Fomos ficando sós* by Adrián Canoura (2017).

Alongside her editing work, she develops her own projects, focused on memory, cinema, and the material nature of the image. She is especially interested in celluloid and amateur formats, which allow a closer, physical relation with the image. Her works include *A Loba* (2020) and *Usos e costumes*. 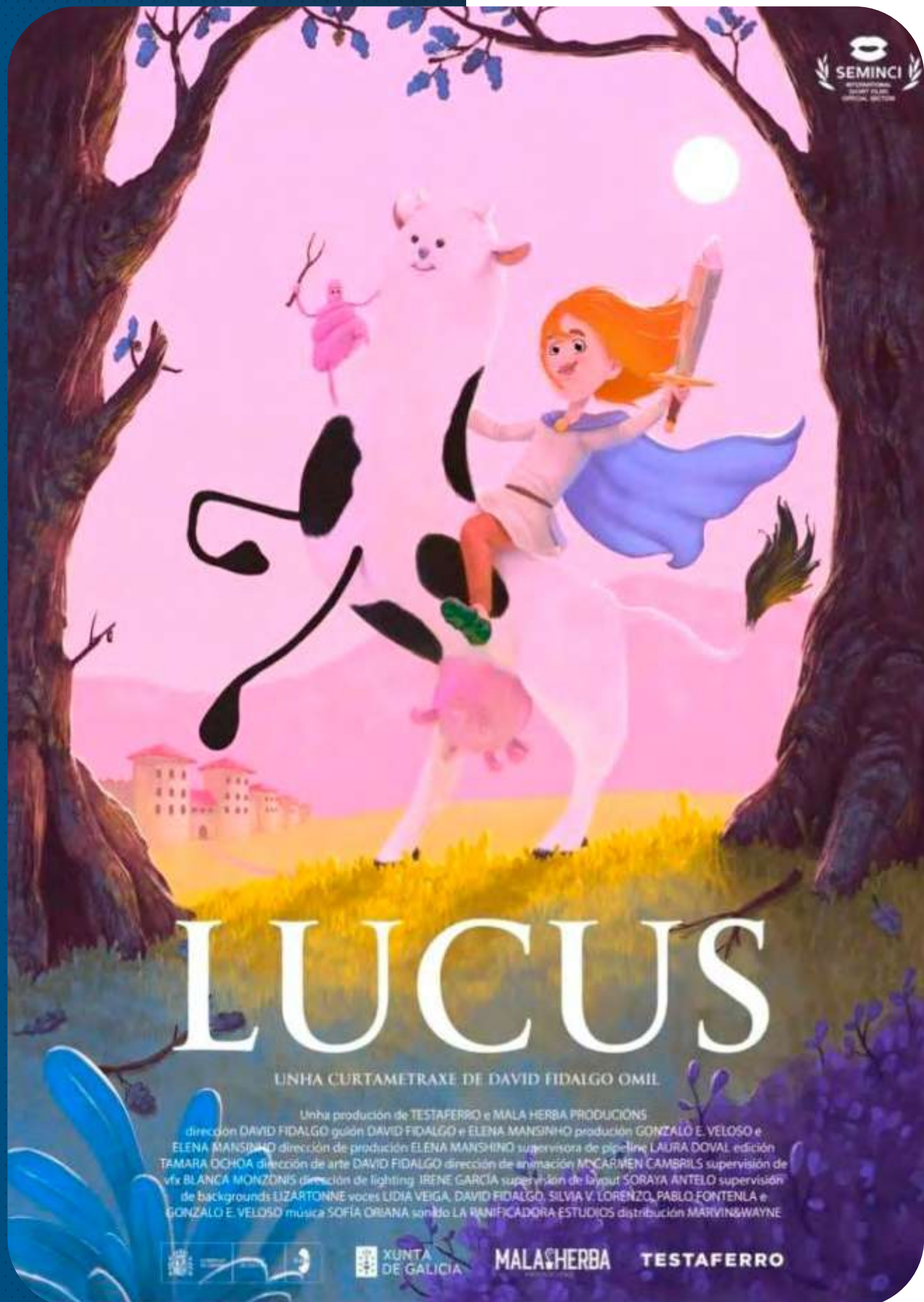

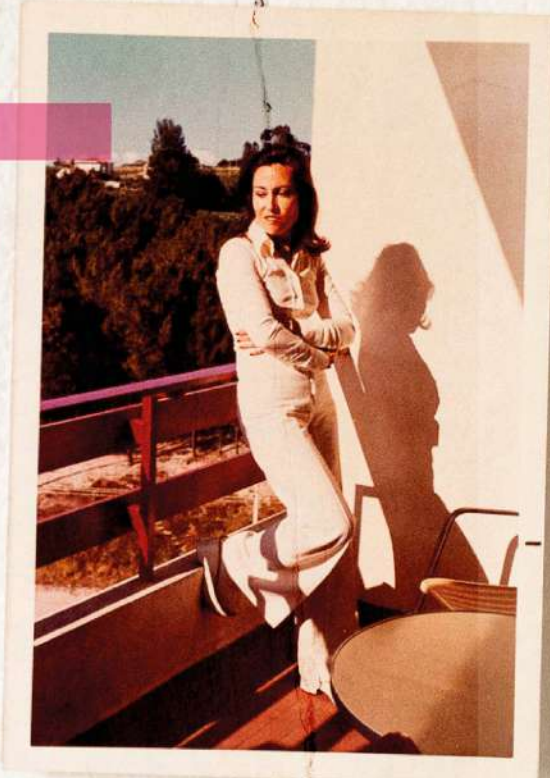

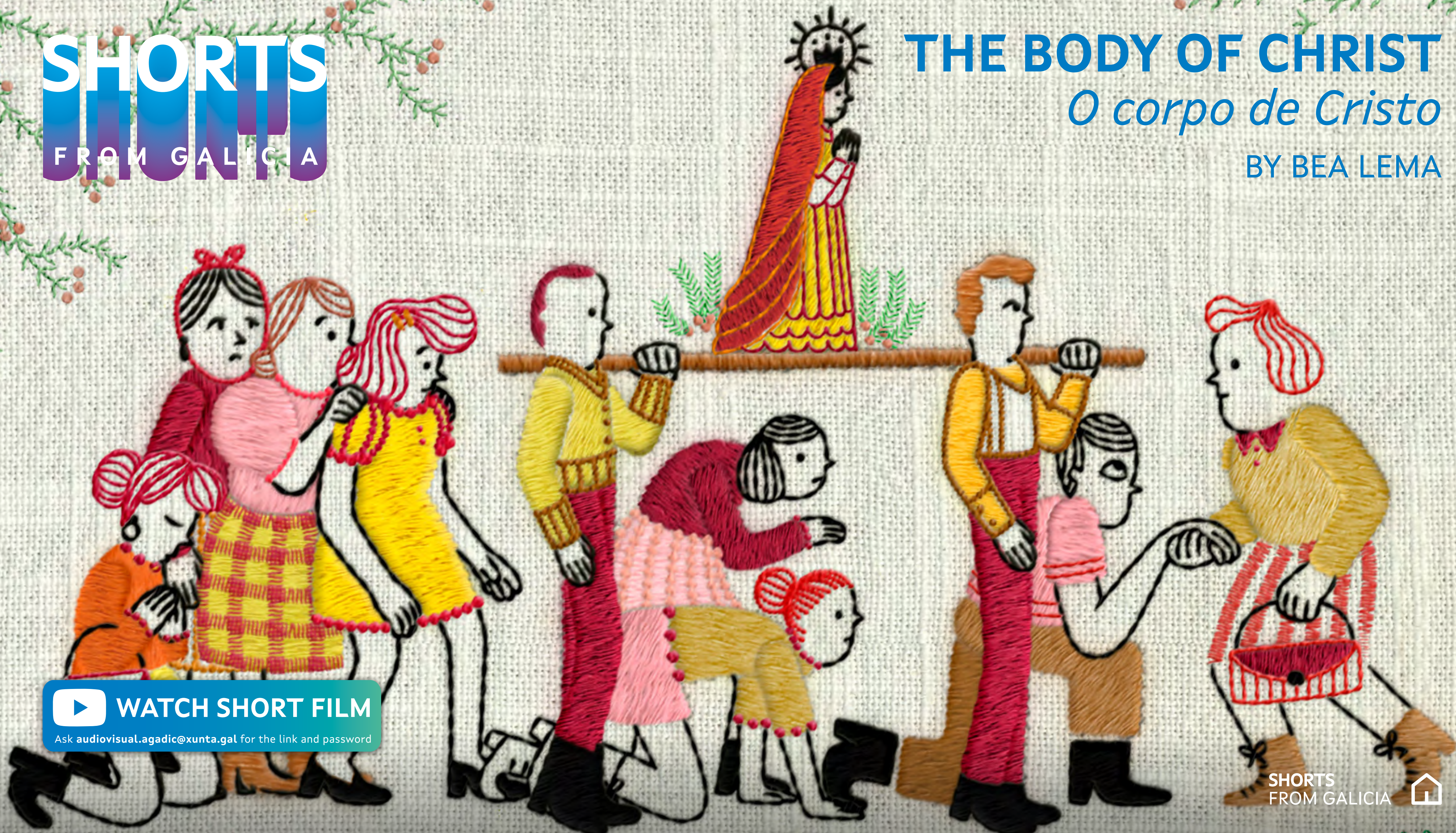
DIRECTOR'S BIO

SYNOPSIS
